Visit the **Union Buildings**, **Voortrekker Monument** and several other significant structures at **Church Square**. Afterwards, transfer to Johannesburg for dinner and an overnight stay.

DAY 5 JOHANNESBURG ▶ CAPE TOWN

Breakfast, Lunch

Depart via a domestic flight to **Cape Town**, the Mother City. Upon arrival, embark on a city orientation, which will take you to the **Houses of Parliament**, **City Hall**, **Castle of Good Hope**, **Slave Lodge & Co Garden** as well as the colourful dwellings of **Bo-Kaap Malay Quarter**. Ascend to the top of **Table Mountain** by cable car (if weather permits) to have superb view of the harbour and Robben Island. Finally transfer to the vibrant **Victoria and Alfred Waterfront** which boasts a wide variety of specialty shops and arts market.

DAY 6 CAPE PENINSULA

Breakfast, Lobster Lunch

Depart on a full day tour of the **Cape Peninsula**. Take a leisurely drive in the day along the coastal road from **Sea Point**, **Clifton** and **Camps Bay** down to the fishing harbour of **Hout Bay**. Embark on a boat ride to Seal Island to view the seals and seabirds. Have a picture stop at the Twelve Apostles and Llandudno. Continue to the **Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve** along one of

South Africa's most scenic routes. Head to Cape Point with a funicular ride to the lighthouse, you will be rewarded with a breathtaking view of the Atlantic Ocean. Dine on a lobster lunch before continuing to **Boulders Beach**, where you will see a large colony of African Penguins.

DAY 7 CAPE TOWN ▶ STELLENBOSCH ▶ CAPE TOWN

Breakfast, Ostrich Meat Lunch, Full Abalone Dinner

Enjoy a city tour of the historical **Stellenbosch** with the backdrop of the Hottentots Holland mountains, the white gabled Cape Dutch homesteads and the oak lined streets and lanes all blend together to give this place an unforgettable charm. Enjoy some wine tasting at the **Winery Estates**, where you can learn how different wines are made to suit individual taste. Continue to **West Coast Ostrich Ranch** for a guided tour and an ostrich lunch. You can see the many aspects of these amazing birds, their glorious feathers and enormous eggs. Afterwards, visit the **Kirstenbosch Botanical Garden** on the eastern slopes of the Table Mountain. It is the most beautiful garden in Africa and one of the great botanic gardens of the world. Wrap up your day with a top-grade abalone dinner.
